CBR Horizon Tour Series 2012

General Guidelines & Rules:

- **Approval Fee - \$300**
- **Rider insurance - \$2,600 FLAT FEE per performance.**
- Event **WILL NOT** be approved or listed on the web site until the rider insurance fee along with approval fee has been received in the CBR office **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
- CBR Sanctioning Fee-10% of the total prize purse and an additional 10% of total prize purse to go towards the CBR Year-End Rider Bonus Program due to the fee is due within five (5) business days from event.
- A minimum of \$5000 (one-day event) or \$7500 (two-day event) added purse money is required.
- CBR Horizon Entry Fees \$175 (\$100 goes into total pay-off \$75 goes to rider insurance)
- Each contestant that competes at a CBR Horizon Series event is required to hold a CBR permit or Cinch CBR Tour card and complete a CBR Membership Release Form provided by the CBR. Permits must be obtained through the CBR Corporate office in Fort Worth, TX. Permit fee is \$125.00.
- Each contestant has to be 18 years or older to compete.
- **Proof of General Liability Insurance naming CBR as additional insured must be received by the CBR office 30 before the event.**
- Rider insurance (\$75 per rider) will be held out of rider's fees and reimbursed to promoter at the conclusion of the event
- Event results and a copy of all judge's sheets are due to the CBR Office within 48 hours along with an estimated event attendance.
- **Promoter to produce and display** at least two (2) CBR Horizon Series sign in a prominent position in the arena.
- **Photos of signage to be sent to CBR Office within fifteen (15) days after event.**

- CBR Horizon Series Logo to be included in all event advertisement which include but not limited to: (posters, flyers, postcards, radio, TV, daysheets, etc.)and will be supplied by the CBR(CBR will produce posters, flyers, postcards along with daysheets and radio/TV spots for an additional cost to the promoter if desired by the promoter).
- Event announcer to provide at least two (2) announcer mentions during a single performance identifying the CBR Horizon Tour Series
- Event will be an official stop on the CBR Horizon Series Tour
- All livestock should be held to the highest quality possible (Bull marking 21 point or higher)
- All Riders with CBR Horizon Series permits or Cinch CBR Tour cards that are eligible to participate.
- The top five (5) riders in the CBR Horizon Series standings will be eligible to compete in each televised Cinch Tour Event
- Event **format consist of 35-40 contestants with an 8-15 head short round.** Please specify your number format when paperwork is mailed to CBR Office
- Entries will take place approximately two (2) weeks prior to the event thru CBR Rider Administration Entry Office at (936)-462-8099. Information & entry dates will be posted under Riders Region & CBR Horizon Series page on the CBR website at www.cbrbull.com

- All information pertaining to the event will be mailed/emailed to the event producer including: (CBR logos, contestant list, alternate list, pay-out information, insurance forms, membership forms, contact numbers, etc)
- CBR Permit Fee = \$125

CBR Horizon Event Procedures

- You will receive a packet (the week before your event) with all of the files you will need. The CBR Office will FedEx a packet out with the: EF's \$175 (\$100 to pay-off/\$75 to insurance); Permits \$125 sheet to post; back numbers, rider insurance release form (in case someone gets hurt) and the 2012 CBR Rule Book
- All Stock for the CBR Horizon Event has to be emailed in to the CBR no later than 1 week prior to the event date. All stock has to be typed in the CBR Stock Form provided & emailed back to Cicily @ cicily@cbrbull.com in an Excel Format. All Secretary Sheets are in Excel Format.
- Also in the packet will be an envelope labeled with a return address to mail the following: check to the CBR; completed releases & original copy of the judge's sheets, secretary summary sheet, judge's report.
- Event results need to be email to CBR within 24 hours after the event so we can post on the CBR website.
- If there are not 10 guys to ride in the long round there will be a file labeled: Draw back list. You will need to print it out & post by the draw prior to guys checking in so they will know if they are on the drawback list.
- If you have any questions during the event please call or text Cicily, Andy or Terry. Also you will need to email or mail a couple of photos of the CBR signage in the arena.
